
A Letter From Our Chairman of the Board

Residential Program

"Selah" is a Hebrew word which means to "pause, rest and reflect." This is exactly what each survivor experiences at home on our serene campus. We are not a shelter, but a home...what you would want for your own daughter. There is a spirit of excellence throughout each home, teaching survivors that they deserve dignity and a safe, peaceful place to heal.

The Residential Program takes a holistic approach to restoration. Survivors, who have had everything stolen from them, get the stability and rest they need to dream again! While in our program, survivors are equipped with the wrap-around services and resources they need to be free. They can also accomplish goals they never knew were possible to tackle - things like getting their GED, reconnecting with their children and family, getting their driver's license, and even learning to swim.

Selah Freedom provides a three-phase Residential Program to survivors of sex trafficking and exploitation, with two safe houses in the Southwest Florida area and two in the Midwest. First, survivors enter the Rest Phase, which allows them to reflect and decide if they are prepared to move forward with stepping into the new life Selah Freedom offers. The second phase is the Restore Phase, where women receive a personalized education plan, medical aid, trauma therapy, job placement, case management, and restorative services. They also have the opportunity to build healthy and safe relationships that will follow them into their final stage of the program. The final stage is the Relaunch Phase, in which survivors receive individualized planning and assistance with living independently, career goals, and continued support. Selah Freedom is there with them every step of the way through their transformation!

Outreach Program

Selah Freedom provides outreach on the streets and in the jails through our sex trade support group, case management and resources for survivors of sex trafficking and exploitation. Selah Freedom partners with local law enforcement as the first point of contact for women identified as sex trafficking victims or at high risk of being recruited into sex trafficking. We are also proud to partner with the FBI, the United States Attorney's Office, and more, to reach survivors and bring them life-saving solutions.

Survivors who are still "in the life" are able to attend weekly groups and receive the resources they need, as well as build a trusting relationship with Selah Freedom. Once a woman is ready to step into freedom, Selah Freedom brings her into a place of safety and restoration.

Selah Freedom is proud to be a part of the collaboration that launched TYLA (Turn Your Life Around), a prostitution diversion program. The TYLA initiative is a partnership between the Sarasota Police Department, Florida State Attorney's Office, First Step of Sarasota and Selah Freedom that employs community outreach, diversion, and a re-directed law enforcement philosophy. TYLA is also supportive during judicial proceedings and is committed to each survivor we serve.

Selah Freedom actively trains law enforcement locally and across the country on how to confront sex trafficking and exploitation and in 2016 trained and partnered with Houston Police Dept during the Super Bowl, the nation's highest ranking sex trafficking event.

Prevention Program

One out of three girls and one out of five boys is sexually abused and the average of entry into sex trafficking is between 12-14 years old. Selah Freedom's passion is to prevent youth from being sex trafficked and exploited before it happens. Our Prevention Program is designed to educate, empower and equip students to recognize the tactics of predators, risk-factors, what to do if they are endangered, and how to avoid exploitative relationships.


We provide 6-8 week prevention groups for girls which are survivor and clinician led. These groups identify the realities of "the life" and what exploitation really looks like, as well as build self-esteem and allow for open, non-judgmental conversation about this issue. They have a high success rate at preventing them from being commercially sold later, as participants become advocates for the cause by taking part. These groups are vital in helping girls discover the power of their voice.

Selah Freedom also brings relevant and engaging education about sex trafficking to both girls and boys by presenting in the classroom, in youth groups and youth conferences across the country through our Freedom for Teens Curriculum. This curriculum is designed to fit into Health Class standards of the public school system so that it can be taught within two classroom sessions.

Selah Freedom also provides Teen Mentorship for at-risk girls through our Prevention Program. Building relationships based on trust and experience is an essential component in helping teen girls build self-confidence, set future goals, and protect themselves against abuse.

Awareness Program

Selah Freedom brings awareness about sex trafficking and exploitation to individuals across the country. Each year, we provide trainings through our Speakers Bureau and presence at community events. We are dedicated to raising awareness about this issue through our dynamic and moving presentations tailored to audiences of students, civic clubs, parents, nonprofits, first responders, hospital staff, educators, legislators, the faith community, and more.

We provide expert training on the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children. This training gives an in-depth look at the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC). Selah Freedom offers this multimedia education training that is open to the community. Receive a deeper understanding of this issue and learn more about the population Selah Freedom serves.

This year, Selah Freedom introduced an awareness presentation, in conjunction with our Prevention Program, entitled "Sex, Lies & Media." This training enlightens parents and those who work with youth on the tactics of predators, how social media platforms are used to lure in innocent children, how to initiate and sustain life-saving conversations with children and teens about this issue, and how to become an advocate for the cause. "Sex, Lies & Media" is also offered to youth to bring them the resources they need to be aware and take action to keep themselves safe in the digital age.

Since our inception in 2010, Selah Freedom's programs have doubled and tripled annually. We are successfully offering services in the Midwest and Florida, and are now focusing on expanding in New York and LA.

The Midwest is now home to all four of Selah Freedom's programs, which originated in our headquarters state of Florida: Residential, Awareness, Outreach and Prevention. Each market is in desperate need of our proven services.

Continued expansion has been made possible thanks to the generosity of supporters such as an Anonymous donor, The Chauncey and Marion McCormick Foundation, an Anonymous Donor and The Pentecost Family Foundation. Their matching gifts exceeding \$1.5 Million have aided in our programs launching and sustaining in each market.

Our Prevention Program is one we are most passionate about and are excited to announce that it has taken on an even larger scope to address the needs of American youth. We have created multiple custom curriculums, including workshops for parents, and one designed specifically for the school system to reach both boys and girls. And we are excited to expand into A with a very strong partnership.

Our Residential Program has grown, too, as we will launch our largest Residential Campus, yet, which will support 22 beds in the Midwest.

Selah Vie Boutique also launched its second premiere location as a sought-after upscale resale boutique and awareness hub in the community. Our grand vision has always been to launch "Selah Freedom Village," which will incorporate survivor businesses, a cafe, retail and more, as a model for strategic sustainability.

We have been upheld by the state of Florida as the model organization serving this population, leading our organization to establish national recognition by Congress, Law Enforcement, the NFL and national press.

Custom modular homes to replicate our unique Residential campuses in each market are underway. We are working with national leaders in this space and plan to have them fully funded and complete in 2018. These homes enable Selah Freedom to provide state of the art graduate housing for survivors in our program, allowing our team to provide the vital continuum of care needed after survivors graduates.

These homes are fully customized and maintain the Selah Freedom spirit of excellence we hold dear. Our goal is to provided survivors with a high level of dignity and comfort on their journey to restoration...a place to heal like you would desire for your own daughter.



We will also be breaking ground on **Julie's Place**, funded by the generosity of Anonymous donors. This space will provide counseling rooms, art therapy, fitness, education, and survivor entrepreneurial opportunities.


Naming rights and "adopting" each room to transform for survivors are available for each modular graduate home.


2016 Revenue

Parties With A Purpose




